







DAY 1

Start your visit in the city and set out on a harbour cruise.

Part of Stonehammer UNESCO Global Geopark's vast array of experiences, this boat tour allows you to witness the power of the Bay of Fundy tides firsthand while you learn about how the immense flow of water has played a part in shaping the earth's geology over millions of years. (Tour duration: 1 hour)

Once you're back on dry land, head to Market Square and pick a place to eat with an outdoor patio so you can enjoy the local fare, fresh air and waterfront scenery while vou dine.

DAY 2

Grab a coffee and lunch-to-go in Market Square before you hit the road because today, you're going to the Fundy Trail (less than an hour's drive from the city centre).

The trail will take you on a picturesque hike along the coast, from clifftop paths, past waterfalls, through the woods and right down to the ocean floor, with scenic lookouts providing pit stops along the way. Hike, bike, or drive it!

Travel time to and from the city: approx. 2 hours (round trip)

Exploration time: That's totally up to you! There's so much to see and do along the Fundy Trail - you'll notice something different every time.

DAY 3

Get an early start and head to Carleton Martello Tower for panoramic views of the Bay of Fundy and the city – the perfect backdrop for a selfie!

Next up, a one-of-a-kind rock climbing expedition at Rockwood Park, another great stop within Stonehammer UNESCO Global Geopark.

Finish the evening under the stars with live music along Market Square's boardwalk.

DAYS 4 & 5

Spend a few hours at the New Brunswick Museum learning about the region's natural wonders and the magnificent sea creatures that call the Bay of Fundy home.

If you want to squeeze every drop of outdoor exploration out of your stay, sites throughout Stonehammer UNESCO Global Geopark (like the Fundy Trail) offer endless opportunities to connect with Mother Nature, like kayaking, birdwatching, ziplining, camping and lakeside dining!

You might even want to stay a few more days.;)
