Discover Saint John

With its charming, historic streets, dozens of restaurants, bars and galleries in its uptown and the beautiful Bay of Fundy on its doorstep, Saint John, New Brunswick is a vibrant city full of urban adventure on the edge of nature.

The Bay of Fundy, home to the world's highest tides, offers excitement and thrills in the heart of the city with the Reversing Rapids. And as Canada's first incorporated city (inc. 1785), Saint John boasts unspoiled historical treasures, like the City Market and the Imperial Theatre, on almost every corner.

Population and climate

Approximately 120,000 people live in Greater Saint John, and 750,000 in New Brunswick, Canada's only officially bilingual province. Saint John has a temperate climate of approximately 22°C or 72°F in summer and 3.9°C or 25°F in winter.

- 15.5-hour drive or 2-hour flight from Toronto, Ontario
- 10-hour drive or 90-min flight from Montreal, Quebec
- 4-hour drive or 40-min flight from Halifax, Nova Scotia
- 3-hour drive from Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island

Top attractions

Reversing Rapids

Where the Bay of Fundy tides - the highest in the world - rush up and over the Saint John River, they collide spectacularly, and the river actually reverses in the face of this unstoppable power. You can enjoy a meal at the restaurant overlooking the water, a gift shop, a theatre, observation decks, skywalk, trails along the water, a zipline and harbour cruise.

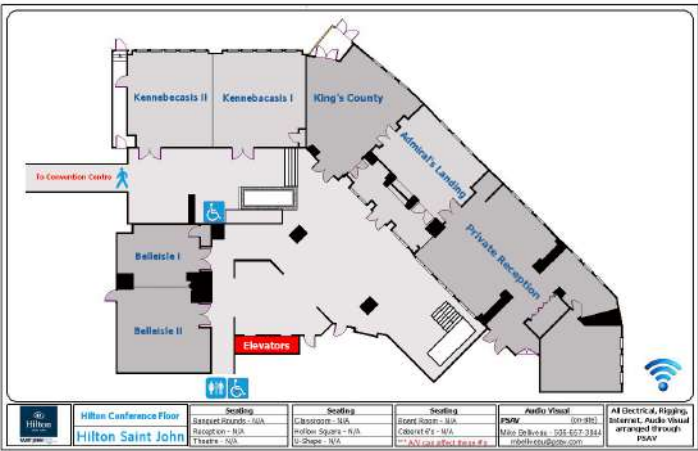

The Saint John Trade and Convention Centre is managed by Hilton Saint John for the City of Saint John. It features 23,454 sq ft of meeting space including the foyer, and nine meeting rooms – the largest seats 2,300 theatre-style and 1,300 banquet-style.

There is underground parking for 500, street level access to the Great Hall, wheelchair accessibility, and a Welcome Registration Centre with adjoining boardroom for efficient registration. 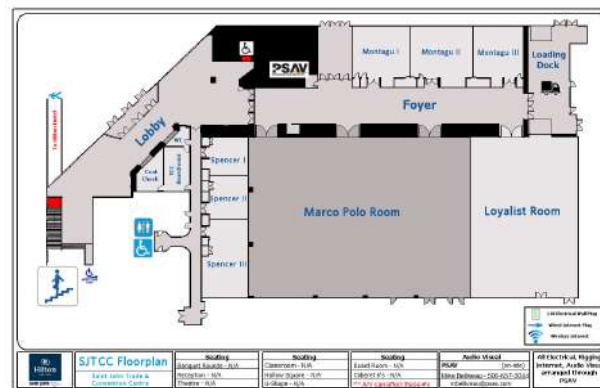

The New Brunswick Museum, located at Market Square, is a 62,000 sq ft facility featuring three levels of history, natural sciences, decorative and fine art exhibitions. Conference groups can relive the province's lumbering and shipbuilding past, or learn about the highest tides in the world, one of the Bay of Fundy's marine wonders.

For meetings and events, the Museum offers several meeting rooms – the largest seats 115 theatre-style with an adjacent spacious foyer suitable for receptions. The Hall of Great Whales serves as a spectacular backdrop for an event with a capacity to hold 200 for stand-up receptions and 100 for sit-down dinners.

The Museum is ideally located within the pedway system that connects hundred of shops, services and restaurants, with convenient indoor heated parking available.

Market Square Atrium is an ideal central location for events and exhibits with the capacity to seat up to 450 and standing room for up to 1,000.

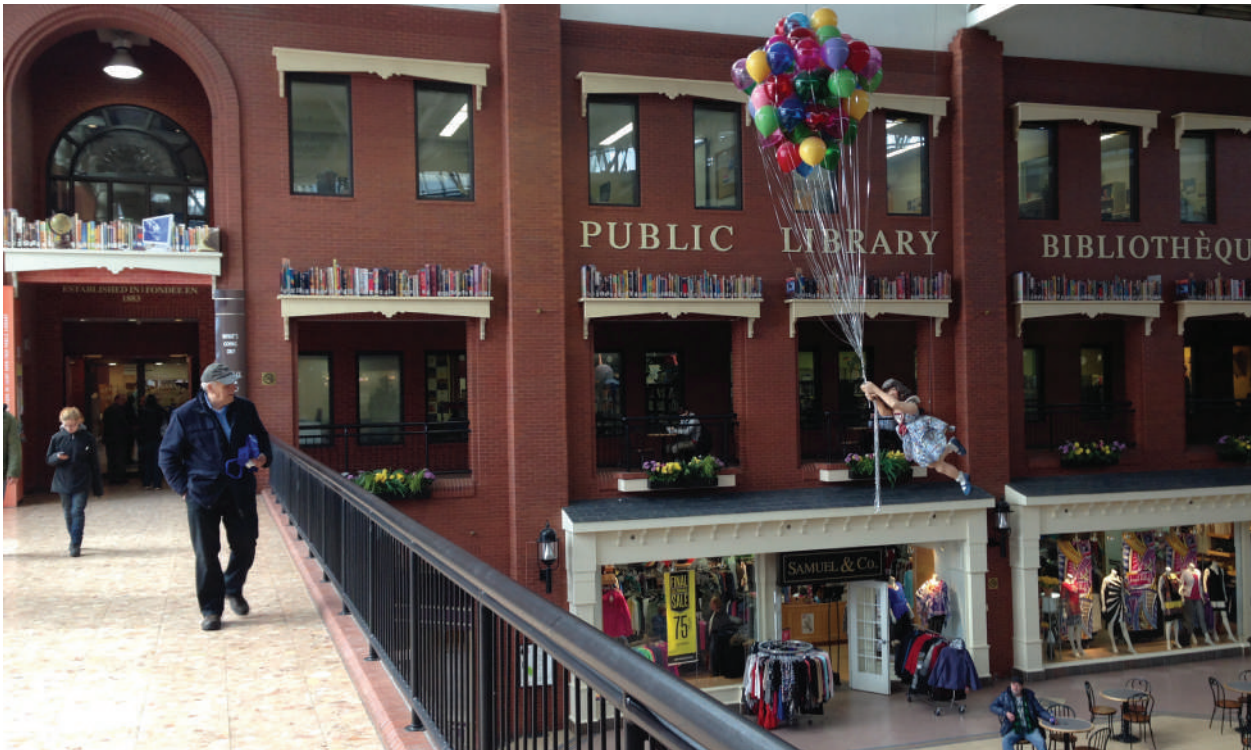

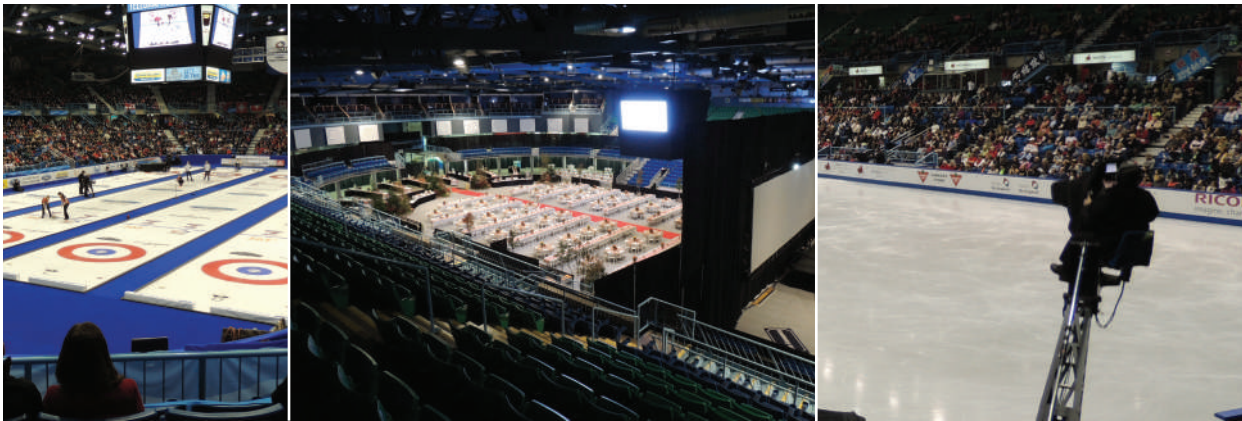

Harbour Station is a multi-purpose entertainment, sports and convention/trade show facility located in Saint John's uptown core. It is recognized as one of Eastern Canada's most popular and successful venues.

Since opening its doors in 1993, Harbour Station has hosted a myriad of world-class events, including most recently Skate Canada International and World Women's Curling. It also serves as the home of the 2011 Memorial Cup champion Saint John Sea Dogs of the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League and the Saint John Riptide of the National Basketball League of Canada.

Although sports remain a highlight on the Harbour Station schedule, the facility is also a popular concert and live music venue. In the past, it has hosted the Canadian Country Music Awards, Cirque du Soleil and the East Coast Music Awards. Harbour Station has also welcomed many big name performers to its stage, such as Carrie Underwood, Brad Paisley, James Taylor and Elton John.

One of Harbour Station's greatest assets is its connection to many nearby amenities via indoor walkways. The "Inside Connection" links the facility to the Delta and Hilton Saint John hotels, shopping, restaurants & bars and indoor parking – all within easy walking distance.

Harbour Station was constructed so it would have the flexibility to host a wide variety of events in a multitude of configurations. With 6,200 permanent seats and additional portable seating bringing the total to near 8,000, the facility is sized to accommodate the requirements of almost any event or performer.

Removable seats and hockey dasher boards enable the facility to be transformed into the largest floor in Atlantic Canada with 50,000 sq. ft. of unobstructed floor space on the main level plus an additional 28,000 sq. ft. on the concourse level. Its technical capabilities are considered second to none in Eastern Canada.

No matter how big or small, Harbour Station can host almost any type of show or event, including tournaments, competitions, concerts, trade shows and conventions. You can be assured of a first-class experience at Harbour Station. We look forward to hearing from you!
