



STROLL HARBOUR PASSAGE

Interpretive structures and panels along the way bring Saint John's vibrant shipbuilding and waterfront history to life, and highlight our extraordinary natural environment.

EXPLORE THE IRVING NATURE PARK

The jewel of Saint John's historic west side is located at the end of a scenic coastal road that winds along the Bay of Fundy shoreline. The Irving Nature Park is a 243-ha (600-ac) peninsula of volcanic rock and forest, sandwiched between the open ocean and a wide expanse of tidal salt marsh. Home to many types of migratory and marine birds, the park offers driving and walking trails through primordial forests and amazing views of this precious ecosystem. The park is open from dawn to dusk and offers picnic sites, some with free gas barbecues. Vehicles are permitted in the park from May to November.

DISCOVER WOLASTOQ PARK

Wolastoq means "the beautiful river" in the language of the Maliseet people who once lived on our shores. Built in 2004 by J.D. Irving, Limited, the park overlooks the Reversing Falls Rapids and features a collection of statues of historical Saint John figures. Stroll Wolastoq's walking trails – you will see how these lands provided the Maliseet people with an abundance of food, materials and medicines, while acting as an important transportation route for hunting and trade.

An Experience Like No Other









Our admission includes:

- A 12 minute film that speaks to the tides, history of our city, and how the Reversing Falls Rapids was created.
- There is a meteorite exhibit that crashed to the earth over 4500 years ago.
- Access to the rooftop observation deck which allows you to explore river streams and lovely view of uptown.
- Then there is Skywalk! This steel constructed walkway goes out 28 feet boasting 5 glass tiles that you can stand on and look down below. The skywalk is situated over 100 feet above the water.

PEEK INTO THE ST. MARTINS SEA CAVES


With kilometres of unspoiled, accessible beaches, two lighthouses and an active harbour boasting two covered bridges, St. Martins is home to many lovely vistas. The village is best known for its sandstone sea caves – submerged during high tide and accessible to explorers during low tide. But don't linger too long . . . keep an eye out for the returning tide!

EXPERIENCE THE FUNDY TRAIL PARKWAY

The Fundy Trail Parkway, located 10 km (6.2 mi) east of the town of St. Martins, is an ideal way to experience our spectacular Bay of Fundy coastline. Visitors to this low-speed auto parkway and walking/cycling trail will wind past pristine beaches, waterfalls tumbling down ancient cliffs, and along a shoreline sculpted by thousands of years of the world's highest tides. Bring your camera and expect to stop often to take in glorious vistas at the many lookouts along the way. Be sure to stop in at the Interpretive Centre and take a short hike across the suspension footbridge that stretches across the clear waters of Big Salmon River. A connector road to Sussex is scheduled to open in 2020, only adding to this spectacular, scenic coastal route.

RELAX AT NEW RIVER BEACH PROVINCIAL PARK

Sit back and relax for the day at New River Beach Provincial Park. A huge stretch of sand along the Fundy Shore, this saltwater beach offers tidal pools abundant with crabs, periwinkles, whelks and starfish; maritime vistas of offshore islands and fishing boats, and birdwatching opportunities for those looking to add shorebirds to their lifelist. The park's facilities include walking trails and boardwalks, campsites, a playground, volleyball courts and three rustic shelters air-conditioned by the Fundy breeze. Open mid-May to the end of September

A getaway to nature, adventure and discovery just 90 minutes from Saint John. Explore the forest or the shoreline. Experience the tides of the Bay of Fundy. Spectacular panoramic views of coastal cliffs and rolling forested hills.



ENJOY A DAY IN SAINT ANDREWS BY-THE-SEA


Located just 60 minutes west of Saint John, Saint Andrews by-the-Sea is Canada's oldest seaside resort town. Popular attractions include Kingsbrae Gardens, Huntsman Fundy Discovery Aquarium and historic Minister's Island. While in Saint Andrews set out on the seas in search of whales, take in a round of golf or stroll along the waterfront stopping to peruse the unique shops.


HOP THE FUNDY ISLES

The Fundy Isles are just a short drive and ferry ride away from Saint John. Plan to visit Campobello Island – the former summer home of FDR, the 32nd U.S. president – and, along the way, discover the Old Sow Whirlpool, the largest whirlpool in the Western Hemisphere, just off the southern tip of Deer Island. Or head to Grand Manan Island, the largest of the Fundy Isles and famous for its dulse, to enjoy biking, hiking and a visit to Swallowtail Lighthouse. Whichever of the Fundy Isles you decide to visit, whales, porpoise, seals and seabirds are abundant.

TAKE A LEISURELY DRIVE ON ROUTE 790

Enjoy the sea air and rugged coastline while traveling along Route 790 through the communities of Chance and Dipper Harbours and Maces Bay. Enjoy birdwatching near a saltwater marsh, stop to view the breathtaking Lepreau Falls or visit New River Beach for family fun. Approximately 30 minutes west of Saint John.



DISCOVER THE SAINT JOHN CITY MARKET

The Saint John City Market, the oldest continuing farmer's market in Canada, is a National Historic Site. It's also where Saint John goes for local produce, fresh meats, the best fish and chips, handmade crafts and a great cup of coffee. Named Canada's 2013 Great Public Space – the market is the beating heart of this historic city.

MUSTER AT THE CARLETON MARTELLO TOWER

Built for the War of 1812, this tough stone fort is a classic example of a Martello Tower – a small circular defense structure first built during the Napoleonic Wars. A concrete fire command post was added to the Carleton Martello Tower in WWII to help defend Saint John harbour. A National Historic Site, the Carleton Martello Tower is perched on a high plateau overlooking Saint John, and has a commanding view of the entire harbour. While the historic tower is currently closed for a major restoration, visitors can explore the grounds and discover more about the fort in the nearby visitor centre.

Site of an English fort built in 1778, this location offers panoramic views of the city and its harbour from Magazine Street in North Saint John.

STEP BACK IN TIME AT BARBOUR'S GENERAL STORE

STEP THROUGH TIME AT LOYALIST HOUSE

Loyalist House, the former home of the Merritt family – loyalists who emigrated from the United States after the Revolutionary War – was constructed in 1817. It was one of the few surviving structures after the Great Fire of 1877. A National Historic Site, the home's Georgian features remain largely untouched, including its original grand staircase – which remains as it was so many years ago. Acquired by the New Brunswick Historical Society in 1959, the home is an amazing example of the quality of early Saint John craftsmanship.

SWING BY THE KING'S SQUARE BANDSTAND

The King Edward VII Memorial Bandstand, with its copper roof and its filigree metal framework, was constructed in 1908 as a gift to the city – donated by the City Cornet Band. It quickly became a favourite location for musical interludes in King's Square.

TOUR THE CARNEGIE BUILDING

Since its dedication on June 24, 1904, the Carnegie Building has remained an architectural jewel in Saint John. This lovely Beaux-Arts style building was formerly the home of one of the oldest public libraries in Canada, built with a donation of \$50,000, given to the City of Saint John by the famous American philanthropist, Andrew Carnegie. Today the building houses the Saint John Arts Centre.

WANDER THROUGH THE OLD (LOYALIST) BURIAL GROUNDS

The Old Burial Ground is referred to by many names, most commonly the Loyalist Burial Grounds. The leafy, peaceful and park-like area is the final resting place of some of Saint John's earliest settlers – including many Americans loyal to the British crown, who emigrated from the United States during and after the American Revolutionary War (1775 - 1783). The earliest gravestone is that of Coonradt Hendricks, dated July 13, 1784. The Old Burial Ground was carefully restored by the Irving family in 1995, in memory of the late K. C. Irving (1899-1992), founder of the Irving group of companies. Sydney Street and King Street East

At an hour and a half each, the self-guided Loyalist Trail, Victorian Stroll and Prince William Walk, will take you through the history and landmarks associated with our earliest settlers, the post-Great Fire residential renaissance and the emergence of turn of the century grand commercial architecture.

VISIT THE SAINT JOHN FIREFIGHTER'S MUSEUM

Construction on the #2 Engine House began in 1840, to help Saint John meet the needs of a growing community. It survived the Great Fire of 1877 and today, the Old #2 Engine House Museum, serves as an exhibit space for an extensive collection of firefighting artefacts tracing the history of firefighting in Saint John. The museum also offers visitors a special exhibit on the Great Fire.

The Saint John Police Museum is a treasure-trove of Saint John Police Force history — including old uniforms, billy sticks, handcuffs, badges, arrest books and photographs. 





If you're looking to take a dip, Saint John and the surrounding area have you well-covered. 

HIKING

Saint John offers a variety of great hiking experiences – many of them accessible to all skill levels. Seven trails at the Irving Nature Park take you past tidal pools, salt marshes, bogs, beaches and the Fundy coastal forest – either on foot, or by car on the low-speed auto loop. At Rockwood Park you'll find more than 50 km (31.1 mi) of all-season trails, allowing you to experience the park during the glorious spring and summer months, but also during the fall, when the forest turns into a brilliant canopy of red, yellow and gold – and in the colder months, when it becomes a winter wonderland.

Just 15 minutes from the city, there are many other hiking opportunities, including historic Mispec Park, with 5 km (3.1 mi) of ocean-side and forested hiking trails. And no list of New





Brunswick trails would be complete without mentioning the exquisite Fundy Trail Parkway.
