Explore More of the International Sculpture Trail

The Schoodic International Sculpture Symposiums produced 34 sculptures along the Maine coast. Sculpture Saint John's International Sculpture Symposium has resulted in a Canadian sculpture trail of 38 large scale sculptures. Combined, the two trails make up a unique international art exhibition of seventy-seven large scale granite works of contemporary art by world renowned artists, and over half of the Canadian pieces can be found in the Saint John Region.
