

SPORT VENUES

Our venues understand the standard of excellence that is demanded to host a national event, and our community is ready.

CANADA GAMES AQUATIC CENTRE

Located in the city centre and connected to many amenities via an "inside connection" pedway system, this facility plays host to major aquatic sports events, recently hosting the Maine State Swim Championship & Atlantic Cup. The pool facility includes a 50m eight-lane pool and diving complex, 2 x 25m warm water leisure pools and a tots pool, as well as on deck hot tubs, sauna, and steam room. **\$25M+ of renovations are commencing in 2026 including warm-up lanes and expanded seating, expected to be completed by the end of 2028.**



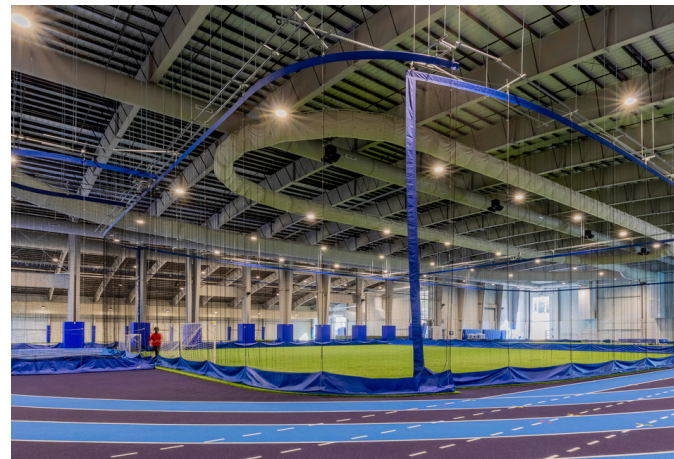
CANADA GAMES STADIUM & UNB ATHLETIC CENTRE

Ranked among the best facilities in Atlantic Canada, playing host to numerous sports including, soccer, football, rugby, field hockey and lacrosse. With a seating capacity of 5,000 this stadium is a premier hosting site for local, regional, national and international track & field events.

UNB's G. Forbes Elliot Athletic Centre features a 30,000 sq. foot surface with an all purpose synthetic floor. It includes space for four basketball courts, four tennis courts, four volleyball courts, six badminton courts, and a four lane running track.

IRVING OIL FIELD HOUSE

Home to a 200-meter, 6-lane indoor track, a long jump pit, high jump, shot put, and pole vault, as well as two indoor turf fields that are each 92 x 172 feet with 8 team change rooms. The turf is suitable for a wide variety of sports such as soccer, lawn bowling, football, rugby, ultimate Frisbee, softball or baseball land training, cheerleading, ball hockey, lacrosse, and field hockey. **\$50M expansion including twin pad ice surfaces and multi-purpose recreation/meeting rooms expected to open in 2029-2030.**



TD STATION

Recognized as one of Eastern Canada's most popular and successful venues, TD Station has a capacity of 6,300. Centrally located in the region's uptown core, TD Station is connected to many amenities via an "inside connection" pedway system. Recently hosting and hoisting the 2022 Memorial Cup championships - TD Station is also home to the Saint John Sea Dogs of the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League.



QPLEX

Equipped with an NHL regulation size rink, the Qplex offers an accessible viewing, and capacity for 1,500 people. A short 20-minute drive from the city's core - the qplex has a history of hockey success, with experience hosting two marquee events: 2016 TELUS Cup and 2018 World U17 Hockey Challenge.

SUMMIT CENTRE

Featuring a standard NHL regulation size rink with capacity for 537 people, this new arena, located just 25-minutes from the city centre, continues to build on what is already an outstanding history of hosting regional on-ice events. Also home to a community room and a regulation size outdoor soccer field, the Summit Centre is an excellent venue for regional, provincial, and national sporting events.



GOLF

Our region is home to three golf courses perfect for hosting provincial and national tournaments, including Hampton Golf & Country Club, Riverside Country Club, and Golf Rockwood. Each course features unique attributes including stunning nature views, with banquet facilities located on-site or nearby.
